



COVID-19 INFORMATION



- Masks are required for drivers and passengers when coming for inspection.
- Customers will be asked to exit the vehicle and proceed to a customer walkway or waiting area.
- Social distancing requirements are in place.
- Employee temperature checks are conducted prior to the start of shift.
- Inspectors are utilizing proper PPE (Personal Protective Equipment); they are required to wear masks, goggles & gloves.
- Inspectors are performing touch point disinfecting.
- Hand sanitizer is available.

Please be advised of the following:

- Customers have the option of presenting their vehicle to a Private Inspection facility. These facilities also perform State Inspections (for a fee) but you would need to contact them directly regarding their operations. (You can find locations under *Popular Topics, Inspection Facility Locator*).
- *Anyone* with a valid driver license can bring a vehicle to inspection, it does not have to be the registered owner. Whomever is bringing the vehicle would be asked to present their own driver license, the vehicle registration card and insurance card.
