

Ready for Inspection?

Present at inspection:

- Valid Driver License
- Vehicle Registration
- Proof of Insurance

- Vehicles manufactured in 1996 or later with an illuminated **“Check Engine Light”** fail inspection. Commercial vehicles require a safety and emissions inspection. Passenger vehicles receive emissions-only inspections.
- New Jersey has 25 state-operated facilities (no fee) and over 1,100 certified private facilities (fees will vary). **Facility locator at www.njinspections.com.**
- No appointments needed at most state-operated facilities. Check wait times at **www.njinspections.com or 888.NJMOTOR (888.656.6867).**
- Inspections may be done up to 2 months in advance of the windshield sticker expiration date.
- Upon passing inspection, an approval sticker will be applied to the windshield. **Failed inspections receive a red sticker (at a state-operated facility only) and generate a vehicle inspection report, which indicates reason(s) for failure.**
